## UFCW Scholarship Program Winners Announced

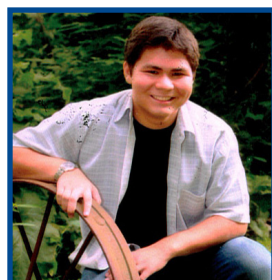

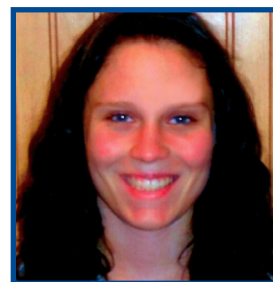
