More than half of us make less than \$10.00 an hour and even if we are eligible for it, most of us cannot afford our employer's healthcare coverage.

As for the rest of us, even with twenty and thirty years of service, we barely make enough to call ourselves the middle class.

Our union contract expires next March and we're expecting Safeway to demand serious cuts in wages, health care, and pension benefits.

We've reached the point where we can't give anymore, so we'll be saying "no" to unwarranted concessions from the company.
