Let me take this opportunity to advise you of how the candidates earned our recommendation.


Local 400 recommends candidates for office only after an exhaustive process of getting to know the candidates, analyzing their records, and reviewing their positions on issues, such as jobs and the economy, workers' rights, health care, retirement security, workers' compensation, education and others. Candidates judged to have your best interests in mind are listed here as guidance. Here is how the process works:

- 1. Local 400 compiles a list of all candidates running for office within their jurisdiction.
- 2. Letters and questionnaires are sent out to all who are running.
- 3. The candidates who complete and return their questionnaires are contacted for personal interviews.
- 4. Based on the questionnaires and interviews, recommendations are made to the executive boards of the respective central labor councils.
- 5. After acceptance, the recommendations are communicated to Local 400 members.
