In fall 2024, thousands of Alliance Union members voiced what we want to fight for in 2025 Bargaining. Thanks to overwhelming participation in the Alliance Bargaining Survey, we know the issues that are important to Alliance members to fight for at the bargaining table. Read on to learn about our priorities, what members shared and what Alliance leaders will be advocating for in 2025 bargaining!

### "BEST WAGES, NOT JUST FAIR WAGES"

Majority of surveyed members said significant wage increases were **VERY important.** Increases should reflect other contract settlements, inflation, labor shortages, increased cost of living and other factors.

Additional priorities include:

- Parity and wage equity
- Addressing wage compression in CA due to minimum wage increases

- No take-aways
- Protect pension and expand retiree medical coverage
- Consistent medical benefits across units and regions
- Increase tuition reimbursement and expand to cover student loans
